MAYENNE 53 NEWS LETTER MARCH 2024





Dave Myers, half of the Hairy Bikers and wellknown resident of Fougerolles du Plessis has passed away aged 66 after a cancer diagnosis in 2022. He and his wife Lily were regular visitors to their house in the centre of the village and supported many local events. An episode of the Hairy Biker TV Program was filmed in his garden here in the Mayenne as part of their Chicken & Egg series.



D5 between Gorron & Vieuvy closed From Monday 19 February to November 2024, the Département de la Mayenne will be carrying out redevelopment work on route départementale no. 5, between Gorron & Vieuvy.

The work includes widening the carriageway and improving visibility at junctions.

During this period, traffic will be banned in both directions between Gorron and Vieuvy, and a diversion has been set up via Lesbois (D 118) and Saint-Aubin-Fosse-Louvain (D 141).





The Noz shop has reopened in Château-Gontier-sur-Mayenne, in the Clémenceau shopping arcade, Having been closed for nearly a year and a half.

Government-imposed decisions on school openings and closures were announced on Monday 5 February 2024. There will be 17 job losses in Mayenne, resulting in 20 class closures, 2 school closures and 2 school mergers.

The following class closures have been decided:

La Rouaudière, resulting in school closure, La Pellerine now the only single class school in the department, Désertines resulting in school closure, Saint Céneré (Montsûrs) Cabrol, Bouère, possible merger with Saint Brice, Beaulieu-sur-Oudon, Hambers, Ruillé Froids-Fond, Charlemagne, Averton, Marcel Pagnol maternelle Laval, Saint Fraimbault, Neau, Mayenne Louise Michel, Dolto élémentaire Laval, Coudray, Château-Gontier J. Guehenno élémentaire, Azé élémentaire, Changé, L'Huisserie.

Yannick Favennec, MP for the Mayenne, welcomed Edouard Philippe, mayor of Le Havre, former prime minister and candidate in the 2027 French presidential election, to Mayenne, near Laval and Gorron, on Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th February 2024.

On Thursday 15th, they visited the economic flagship of the Bocage Mayennais, at Serap (Groupe SERAP) in Gorron.

Yannick Favennec has left Emmanuel Macron's Horizons to join LIOT: The Libertés, Indépendants, Outre-mer et Territoires (LIOT) group was created on 28 June 2022 and has 21 members.



In February 2024, there were only around 45 hours of sunshine in Laval. It was the third least sunny month in Mayenne since 2011. Even so, the weather was very mild, with temperatures 3°C above seasonal norms. More than 80 millimetres of rain fell in Laval in February 2024, compared with just 1.4 millimetres at the same time last year. Good news for the water tables, but the risk of drought this summer cannot be totally ruled out.

Vaiges is a small town in eastern Mayenne with 1166 inhabitants. The river Vaige forms part of the commune's northern border, then traverses the commune's territory from north to south before forming part of its south-western border.

Practically self-sufficient, Vaiges has a Police station, Fire Station, Schools, Post Office, Pharmacy, Library, Banks, Doctor, Dentist, Small Supermarket, Vets, Butchers, Bakery, Garage, Bars & Restaurants!

Just a few minutes from the A81 motorway, it's a 2hr 40 minute drive into Paris, 50 minutes to Le Mans and 30 minutes to Laval.






MANU DAVOUST - BLADESMITH

Manu Davoust has been making knives for five years. He works with steel but also with wood, since he creates the whole thing from scratch. To melt iron, his workshop is equipped with forges that can reach 1000°C. Once forged, the blades take shape and are sanded using an abrasive belt before being polished and then sharpened. The wooden handles are also made by the artisan cutler-blacksmith who works with local wood species.

Manu also likes to pass on his passion and his know-how. He regularly organizes two-day courses. You can learn how to make a knife and you leave with it at the end of the training.



YOUR GARDEN IN THE MAYENNE - MARCH 2024

As winter wanes and the promise of spring looms closer, gardeners in the Mayenne are eagerly preparing for the upcoming growing season. March marks a crucial period for tending to the garden, laying down the foundations for a productive and beautiful Spring! Here are some essential gardening tasks to think about this month:

1. **Prepare the Soil**: With the soil thawing after winter's chill, March is an opportune time to begin soil preparation. Turn over the soil in flower beds and vegetable patches, incorporating compost or well-rotted manure to enrich its fertility. This ensures plants have access to vital nutrients as they begin their growth spurt.

2. **Sow Early Crops**: As the days lengthen and temperatures rise, seize the moment to sow cool-season vegetables like lettuce, spinach, radishes, and peas. These hardy crops thrive in the cooler conditions of early spring, offering an early harvest to enjoy.

3. **Prune Fruit Trees and Bushes**: March presents an ideal window for pruning fruit trees and bushes before they burst into new growth. Remove dead, diseased, or damaged branches, and shape the tree to encourage an open, airy canopy that facilitates better air circulation and sunlight penetration.

4. **Divide Perennials**: Many perennial plants benefit from division every few years to rejuvenate their growth and prevent overcrowding. March is an excellent time to divide plants like hostas, daylilies, and ornamental grasses, ensuring healthier, more vigorous growth throughout the season.

5. **Prepare Seedbeds**: For those planning to start seeds indoors or in a greenhouse, March is the time to prepare seedbeds. Fill trays or pots with a quality seed-starting mix, sow seeds according to their specific requirements, and provide the warmth and light necessary for germination.

6. **Tend to Bulbs and Tubers**: As the first signs of spring bulbs emerge, it's essential to provide them with care. Remove any weeds around bulb beds, apply a balanced fertilizer to promote strong growth, and deadhead spent flowers to divert energy back into the bulb for next year's display.

7. **Mulch and Weed Control**: Apply a layer of mulch to garden beds to conserve moisture, suppress weeds, and regulate soil temperature as the weather fluctuates. Additionally, stay on top of weed control efforts to prevent invasive plants from establishing a foothold.
