

Blue Zone Parking Limits in Mayenne Town

Mayenne town council is launching an awareness campaign aimed at motorists who park their vehicles in the blue zone. Some are staying too long. This preventive phase will last a month. Fines will then be levied.

The town of Mayenne is cracking down on motorists who overuse blue zone parking: "Stop squatting, everyone has a turn in the blue zone" is the slogan for this awareness-raising and prevention campaign, which will run throughout May. City officials will be reminding people of the rules by placing warnings on cars caught breaking the rules, and from June 1, offenders will have to pay a fine of €35.

Petition against cow bells - Villepail

Local farmer, Pierre Damonville, is in dispute with his neighbours due to 30 of his cows causing a noise nuisance by the wearing of bells. A handwritten petition in the village has gathered 60 signatures and Pierre must now carry out a study to analyse the potential noise pollution.

Mr Damonville, originally from Picardy, owns 4 farms and employs 3 people. His dairy herd graze on 80 hectares of land and

he maintains that the bells are necessary to help locate the herd: "Here, we are on the highest point of Mayenne, at an altitude of 400 meters," He has instructed a specialized lawyer from the Paris bar, Thimotée Dufour, to act on his behalf. Pierre Damonville does not plan to remove the bells from his dairy cows for the moment.



The Mairie at Pré-en-Pail are currently asking residents for their opinions on what to do about the town's outdoor swimming pool, closed since 2022. With repairs estimated at 3 million euros, the fate of the swimming pool will be decided at a community council next September.



An Italian-Indian restaurant, "La fourépoêle", to open in Château-Gontier in mid-May

A new restaurant, La fourépoêle, is set to open in mid-May 2024 in Château-Gontier-sur-Mayenne. The menu will include Indian and Italian food.

Golam Rabbane (34) and the restaurant's chef are fine-tuning the menu for the imminent opening.

The restaurant is still being fitted out, but will open shortly (mid-May) at 3, rue René-d'Anjou in Château-Gontier-sur-Mayenne, formerly Chez Alphonso.

The manager, Golam Rabbane, is originally from Bangladesh and came to France as a teenager. After more than 10 years working in establishments in London and Paris, he is now keen to open his own restaurant and, at the same time, get away from the hustle and bustle of the capital.

While waiting for the work to be completed, he and his team are working on adjusting the menu. It's 100% home-made, hand-crafted with fresh, local produce.

The menu will include chicken tikka masala and the traditional milk-based drink, lassi, but with spices tailored to the tastes and palates of the Mayenne people.



Le Justice Nightclub in Mayenne to reopen

Closed since 2021, the Justice Nightclub is set to reopen in mid-May following a favourable visit by representatives from the police, fire service, mairie and prefecture.

Renamed "Club Privé Le Justice", Stéphane Bourd and his partner, Michèle Diacono have successfully appealed to reopen the basement club. The venue can accommodate more than 350 people and will be open on Fridays and Saturdays, until 5 or 6 in the morning, in addition to student evenings on certain Thursdays.



Prince Albert II of Monaco visits the Mayenne

Prince Albert visited the department at the start of the month: He unveiled the Grimaldi Historic Sites plaque thanks to the town of Mayenne joining the association that brings together the former fiefdoms of the Grimaldis of Monaco. Albert II of Monaco is Duke of Mayenne. The town is historically the seat of the Duchy of Mayenne. Created by Charles IX in 1573 and modified over the years, it was acquired by Mazarin in 1654. Albert II inherited it through the marriage of his ancestors: Honoré-Charles Maurice de Grimaldi (the future Prince Honoré IV) married the daughter of the Duc d'Aumont-Mazarin, Louise Félicité Victoire, Duchesse de Mayenne, in 1777. He also presented the prizes for the international piano competition, visited the château and took selfies with the crowds. The Prince continued his tour of the Mayenne region in Fontaine-Daniel, visiting the Toiles de Mayenne company. He also visited Laval to open an exhibition at the departmental archives. The exhibition traces the links between the Grimaldi family and the département.

Gorron Mayor: Conflict of interests

A decision is expected in the case of Gorron Mayor (Jean-Marc Allain) on 16th May following charges of favouritism and conflict of interest concerning council decisions relating to 2 Gorron businesses. Mr Allain's daughter and son-in-law also faced charges in connection to this matter. The prosecutor has asked for 18 months suspended prison sentence and five years of ineligibility for the elected official.



Craon bids to host a casino



The town of Craon in southern Mayenne is hoping to welcome a casino. Since December 2023, the law has changed regarding casinos. From now on, towns with significant equestrian activity can apply for permission to set up a casino. Historically, casinos have been located in seaside resorts, spa towns and large conurbations (over 500,000 inhabitants). But the change in the law to reduce inequalities between regions now allows municipalities with a significant equestrian activity (at least ten national or international equestrian events per year) as well as a national stud farm or the Cadre Noir (the prestigious school for horse riders) to host casinos.

Craon is not the only town that would like to hit the jackpot. A casino brings in almost a million and a half euros a year. At Lion d'Angers, which is less than 40 kilometres from Craon, is also bidding for permission to build a casino. But with Saumur in the same département also in the running, this competition between two Maine-et-Loire towns could well benefit Craon.



The Olympic torch in the Mayenne

The Olympic flame will be travelling through the Mayenne on 29th May. Two separate convoys will be criss-crossing the département. Comprising a number of security vehicles and Paris 2024 partners, these two convoys will provide security for this popular celebration and for the torchbearer.

The engagement convoy will take up positions in the 4 Mayenne towns with a route of around 4-5km, with a change of torchbearer every 200 metres, while the mobile convoy will take up positions in the 3 other towns with shorter routes.

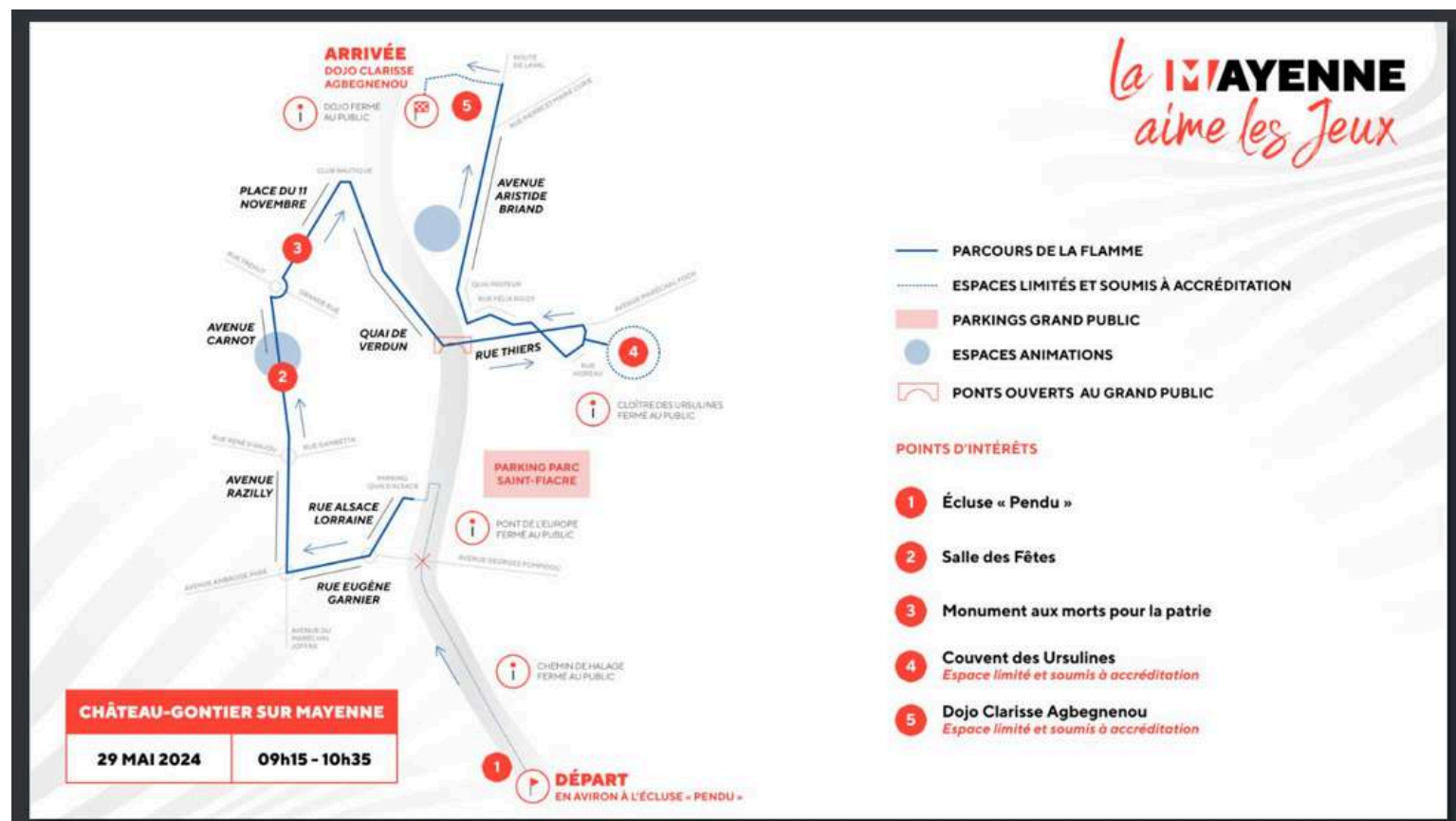
You can expect some traffic disruption in and around the 7 locations throughout the day, due to spectators and security operations. The programme of events will start at Château-Gontier, then continuing on to Cossé-le-Vivien, Sainte-Suzanne, Chailland, Mayenne, Pré-en-Pail and concluding at Laval.

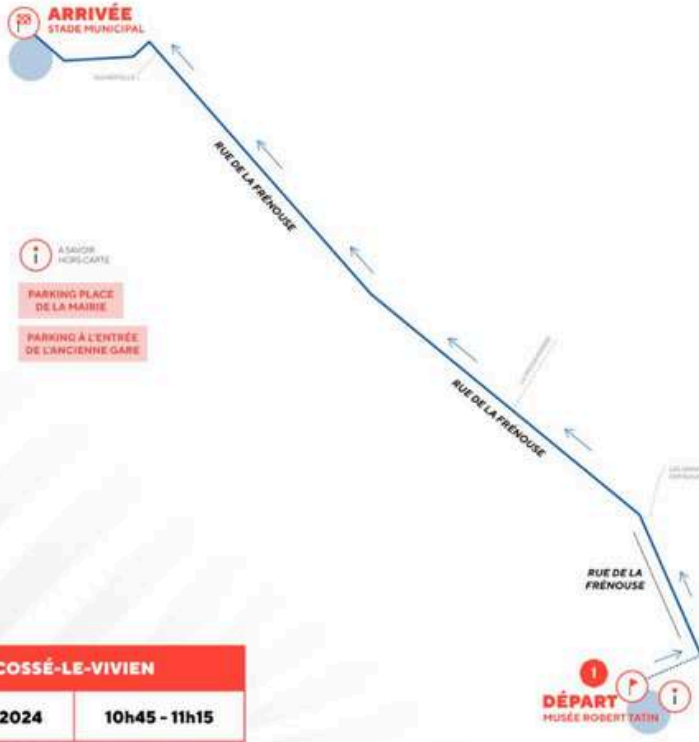
The flame will end its journey at Espace Mayenne in Laval, before igniting the cauldron at the end of the day. This historic moment is open to all, with the celebration site open from 3.30pm.

A variety of activities and entertainment will take place throughout the afternoon at Espace Mayenne; 3.30pm - 7.30pm: Stands manned by Paris 2024 partners and the Département de la Mayenne stand, events and activities for the general public to promote local sport and showcase the département's initiatives.

4pm - 5.30pm: Activities organised by the Département de la Mayenne on the Espace Mayenne forecourt, in association with local sports committees and associations.

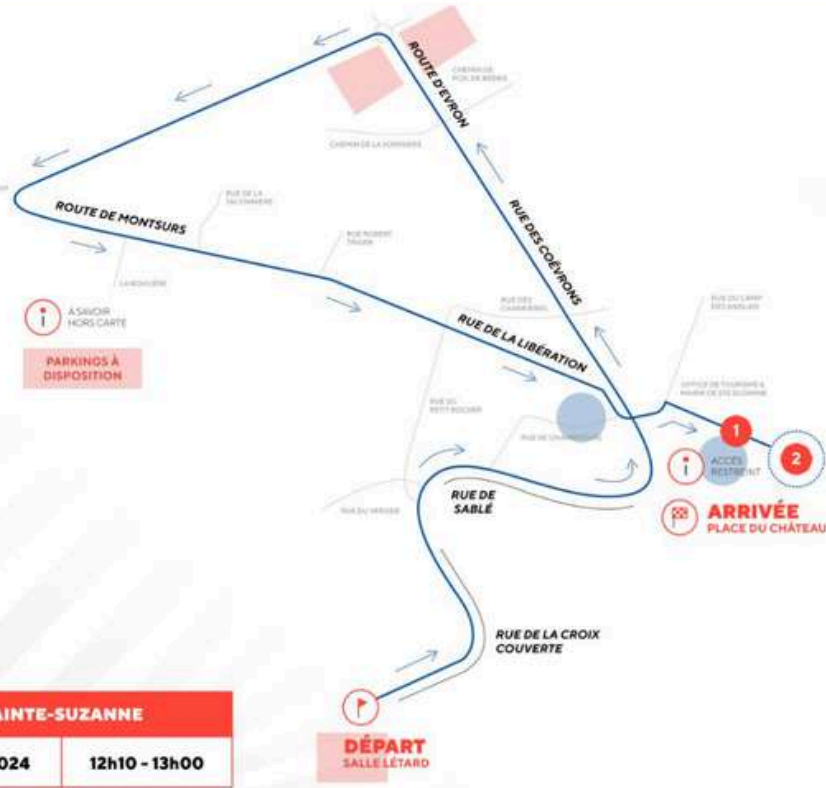

The 6 Olympic torchbearers in the towns

Appointed by the Department on the recommendation of the towns involved.

Daniel Fernandez : An athlete from Mayenne, Daniel Fernandez has competed in the French, European and World Championships in the veteran category. He is the current French record-holder in the 65-70-75-80 age group in the indoor and track high jump events.

Catherine Charles: A committed volunteer and president of the Festival de l'Humour des Embuscades.

Quentin Cornu: Territorial agent with the Conseil départemental de la Mayenne. He is a member of the Intrépide de Pré-en-Pail-Saint-Samson club, where he began his career in the athletics school category.

Mickaël Leroux: An ultra-trail runner from Chailland, he is also a volunteer fireman at the Chailland fire station and is a former chairman of the charity "Pour le sourire de Chloé". In 2023, Mickaël took part in 5 ultra-trails and runs for multiple sclerosis.

Clément Cadieu: Member of the CAE Evron weightlifting club. A regular in this season's National 1 team, he won 2 medals at U20 level, becoming French Champion and setting a French record in the shoulder throw (-55kg) in 2022.

Hortense Vanessa Mballa Atangana: Cameroonian athlete from the Rouen hope centre. A member of the Château-Gontier club, she is a three-time African judo champion and has twice taken part in the Olympic Games: Rio de Janeiro in 2016 and Tokyo in 2021.

4 Olympic torchbearers in Laval

Appointed by the City of Laval.

François Pervis: A former French professional track cyclist, François holds seven track world championship titles, as well as a bronze medal from the 2016 Olympic Games and the 2020 Paralympic Games.

Myriam Clavreul: A multiple French Paracanoe champion, Myriam was recently voted Mayenne Sportswoman of the Year 2023.

Jehanne Mekki: Jehanne is a polo player who plays for Laval Water-Polo. A former captain of the Bleuettes U19s, she recently took part in a training camp with the Bleuettes U20s in preparation for the World Championships.

Tetiana Afanasieva: The young Ukrainian swimmer found refuge in Mayenne after fleeing the war in her country. She swims for Stade Lavallois Natation and won a silver medal in the 400 m 4-swim event at the 2023 French junior championships.

The Torch Relay day will end at Espace Mayenne with the highlight: the lighting of the cauldron. For this moment, 24 people will have the privilege of forming a guard of honour to accompany the arrival of the last torchbearer.

The members of the guard of honour have been chosen according to the values embodied by the Torch Relay, namely to highlight those who make sport and its practice shine; those who undertake, innovate, create and generate progress and represent French-style excellence; and those who are committed to a more caring, inclusive and sustainable society.

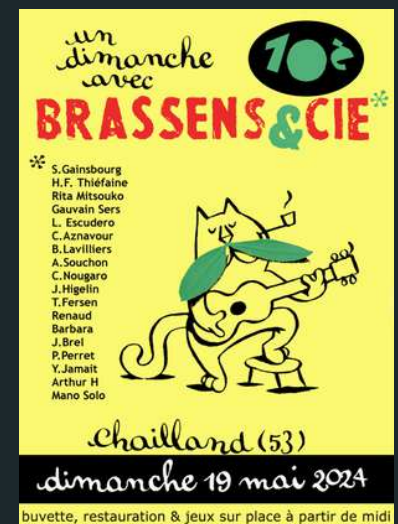

FARMERS PROTESTS CONTINUE

Roads and government buildings continue to be targeted by farmers' unions protesting against EU regulations. Despite France being at the front of the queue for subsidies from the Common Agricultural Policy (receiving up to 9 billion euros in aid per year), French farmers have been showing their displeasure for new rules and standards.

Farmers unions are unhappy about Brussels' refusal to extend the exemption allowing the cultivation of fallow fields which was introduced following food shortages due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine. They also claim to be the victims of unfair competition courtesy of the EU-Mercosur trade deal with Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay which allows foreign farmers to export to the EU without being tied to the same regulations and standards as EU farmers.

Since October 2023, the Fédération nationale des syndicats d'éleveurs agricoles (FNSEA) et du syndicat Jeanes agriculteurs (JA) have been turning village signs upside down in protest at the government's agricultural policies. The campaign, started in the Occitanie region, quickly spread throughout France and has resulted in over 10,000 signs being inverted. With over a third of farmers expected to

reire in the next 10 years, unions warn of a growing crisis as government plans to increase taxation on non-road diesel vehicles and glyphosate pesticides make it harder for farmers to earn a living.

At the time of going to press, the Agricultural Orientation Bill was due to be presented to the French Parliament.

Despite the seasonal demands on farmers, you can expect more protests unless Macron's new Prime Minister Gabriel Attal can offer them more concessions.
